****E-CRASH LOG ENTRY**** A 25 year old man from Canby was Eastbound on Interstate 84 in his silver 2017 Ford Mustang following too closely to a black 2021 Honda Pilot occupied by a couple from Nampa Idaho. The traffic was slowing for an oversized load and when the Honda Pilot hit the brakes at 40 mph the 60 mph Ford Mustang rear ended it in the fast lane. Air bags did not deploy and both vehicles were driven to the shoulder. All three occupants were belted and uninjured. A Trooper came across the scene a few minutes later, took a crash report and provided crash report forms and information exchanges to each driver. The operator of the Ford Mustang was issued a citation for following too close.

The suspect driver was transported to Emanuel where follow up was conducted. The suspect driver was cited and released in lieu of custody to the medical staff. Both vehicles were towed by cascade towing to their lot.
