Narrative summary

The Oregon State Police responded to a report of a white Chevy Astro van that was a hazard. A male believed to be associated with the van was reported to be nearby, in the center median and possibly having as mental health crisis. Upon arrival, the van was observed to have a broken passenger side window, and the ignition was damaged with wires hanging from the steering column. Gilliam County assisted and attempted to locate the male, but he was not located. The registered owner of the van was contacted and advised that no one should have his vehicle and that it had been stolen out of Portland. The registered owner was advised to report the van as stolen to the Portland Police Bureau and also provided Simcoe towing contact info along with a case number. Simcoe towing responded and towed the van as a hazard.
